## Position Description for Executive Council

The London Middlesex Primary Care Alliance (LMPCA) is a grassroots group of community family physicians, nurse practitioners and administrators.

**Vision:** An inclusive network of primary care providers leading with a unified voice to improve the health of our community.

**Mission:** Create a strong and united primary care network to:

- **Lead** system change utilizing quintuple aim values
- **Drive** health equity and continuous quality improvement for the best possible experience and health outcomes
- **Advance** patient-centred equitable care in partnership with those we serve
- **Improve** integration of primary health services with public health and other social and health care partners

By organizing as a sector, we as Primary Care are establishing clear goals, strategies, and processes to have a strong united voice, connect to teams and supports, improve our practice, and focus on equitable representation. As a collective, we are better positioned to identify and act on health system issues, challenges and opportunities.

We are looking for passionate people who see the value in coming together as a Primary Care sector in London Middlesex and are willing to dedicate time and energy to create meaningful change in the health care system.

### EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

The Executive Council will support the work of the LMPCA committees / working groups and provide mission-based, distributed leadership, and strategic governance. As a member of the council, a representative will act in the best interest of primary care as a collective. The Executive Council's relationship is a partnership, and the appropriate involvement of each member is both critical and expected.

#### Responsibilities:

- Act honestly, in good faith and in the best interest of the LMPCA.
- Disclose all conflicts of interest should they arise in a timely fashion to the Executive Council.
- Contribute to defining the LMPCA's strategic directions and approve its strategic plan.
- Select the Co-Chairs for the LMPCA.
- Mentor new LMPCA members.
- Assist in developing and maintaining positive, cooperative and respectful relations among or with other members, committees, management, staff and community.
- Participate on at least one committee, including attendance at meetings.
- Participate in bi-weekly and other LMPCA meetings (i.e. quarterly LMPCA General Meetings).
- Participate in your initial orientation session(s) as well as occasional retreats, education sessions and other gatherings of the Executive Council, as necessary.
- Represent the organization when required or requested, acting as ambassadors for the LMPCA.

#### Requirements:

- Commitment to the vision, mission, values and work of the LMPCA.
- In good standing with appropriate regulating body (i.e. the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, College of Nurses of Ontario).
- Support of LMPCA related events and be working/practising in the London-Middlesex geography.
- Availability to serve a two-year term commitment, eligible for reappointment for one additional term, to a maximum of four consecutive years.
